Yanceyville, The Square & First Fridays!

Yanceyville, the county seat of Caswell County, enjoys a location in the Piedmont Triad region that is nestled in the central north of the state. In the 2020 census, the town had a population of 1,937. The settlement was founded in 1792 and was later named Yanceyville in honor of Bartlett Yancey, Jr.

Yanceyville enjoys the convenience of being almost the same distance from the mountains or the beach, but the small-town charm of Yanceyville is enjoyed by its residents and visitors alike.

Nearby is S.R. Farmer Lake, the Yanceyville Museum of Art Featuring Maud Gatewood, a local park and walking area, as well as a wonderful tribute to our local veterans and fallen first responders.

The town is poised to grow as it is nearby the large casino resort development being constructed across the Virginia border. Because of that and the growth of the Research Triangle Park from the south, the town and surrounding areas are in the midst of experiencing some new growth.

In the quaint downtown located on The Square is an innovative co-working/shared workspace facility, CoSquare, that has been operating the past few years. It is home to numerous professionals representing various fortune 500 companies and others that are

small business entrepreneurs operating out of the offices there. The Caswell Arts Council and Caswell County Chamber of Commerce also call CoSquare home.

Also downtown is the Historic Courthouse and the Richmond-Miles Museum. Several shops are located downtown and provide a nice way to spend an afternoon.

Yanceyville is host to many of the county's activities including the local veteran recognition ceremonies, the annual Independence Day fireworks event, the Bright Leaf Hoedown fall festival in September, and the annual Tree Lighting event and Christmas Parade both on the first weekend in December:


During the summer months, each "First Friday" of the month, there is a community concert provided by the Town of Yanceyville free to area residents. The events include live music featuring a wide variety of regional talent covering all music genres.

Area classic car enthusiasts are always invited to 'Cruise In' and show off their unique vehicles. Cars, trucks and motorcycles are all welcome. The events also have food for purchase from local vendors.

Caswell Facts & Figures.

In 2020, Caswell County, NC had a population of 22.6k people with a median age of 46.2 and a median household income of \$47,938. Between 2019 and 2020 the population of Caswell County, NC declined from 22,684 to 22,619, a -0.287% decrease and its median household income grew from \$45,733 to \$47,938, a 4.82% increase.

The five largest ethnic groups in Caswell County, NC are White (Non-Hispanic) (60.9%), Black or African American (Non-Hispanic) (32.6%), White (Hispanic) (2.05%), Other (Hispanic) (1.86%), and Two+ (Non-Hispanic) (0.955%).

None of the households in Caswell County, NC reported speaking a non-English language at home as their primary shared language. This does not consider the potential multi-lingual nature of households, but only the primary self-reported language spoken by all members of the household.

99.1% of the residents in Caswell County, NC are U.S. citizens.

In 2020, the median property value in Caswell County, NC was \$113,600, and the homeownership rate was 74.2%. Most people in Caswell County, NC drove alone to work, and the average commute time was 31 minutes. The average car ownership in Caswell County, NC was three cars per household. What's New in Old Town? Story & Photos By Angela Daniel-Upchurch


Established in 1796, Milton celebrated her 225th year last December: Gone are the many-storied tobacco factories, the warehouses, the barrel-making, the tin smithing, the saddle shops, carriage shops, the "liveries" for horse boarding and the old hotel, all contributing to the business landscape which made Milton a commercial center in the nineteenth century.

However, much of Milton's past still stands. Several nineteenth-century homes and churches are located along the Town streets; some bear historical information signs, which makes for a pleasant self-walking tour. Milton's "Commercial Row," an 1818 tavern, a c.1835 "General Store," the c.1860 "State Bank" and one small plug tobacco factory remain of Milton's historical commercial structures.

Both the Milton General Store and the Milton State Bank have undergone previous restorations. "The Bank" currently houses the Milton Renaissance Foundation Museum & Visitors Center (336.583.8203) and is available for tours, primarily Saturday afternoons, but is usually available to open when contacted.

The organization hosts historical-interest presentations and has worked behind the scenes toward "renaissance" since its establishment in 2016. The Milton General Store generally opens on weekends for antique shopping. The Union Tavern, more famously known as The Thomas Day House, is in the process of transitioning to be North Carolina's next state historic site, showcasing the life and work of Free Person of Color and noted furniture maker Thomas Day (1801-61). The Thomas Day House is available for tours (336.616.6381) with 48 hours notice, and will be a key site in the upcoming Caswell Council for the Art's Thomas Day Art Walk on October 15 beginning at 10 a.m.

The hip Milltown Eatery & Saloon with a bigger-city vibe and the regionally famous Aunt Millie's Pizza with its ninescoops-of-ice-cream high banana splits both operate in the Milton's Historic Commercial Row. The Milton Studio Art Gallery- a beautiful art haven representing over 65 NC/VA artists- the trendy, repurposed jewelry and home decor shop of Carolina Vintage Co. and Aunt Millie's Antiques also reside in the same Commercial Row. Search for these business' Facebook pages and/or websites for more information.

Some things old... Some things NEW.

While all of Milton is an historic district, and quite noted for being old, several new projects are underway.

The organization which owns **The Claude Allen Plug Tobacco Factory**, Milton Preservation and Beautification Society, was awarded \$15,000 from the Marion Stedman Covington Foundation to begin the long process of stabilization. The post-Civil War structure has suffered significant deterioration. Work is expected to begin before summer's end. Efforts are being made to gain additional funding in order to add this last vestige of Milton's tobacco manufacturing days to the Town's roster of restored structures.

So many of Milton's other structures which supported tobacco manufacturing were located along "Crop Street," an old roadway still owned by the Town of Milton, but long since reclaimed by nature. A committee was formed and work commenced on **The Milton Heritage Greenway & Walking Trail** in May. Funding from Duke Energy, our local Compassion Health Care/Caswell Family Medical Center, CARES Act economic stimulus grants and private donations have made the initial efforts possible.

The goal of the Trail is to provide walking space, in a natural setting, away from the heavy traffic on Broad Street, as well as to highlight the businesses which once operated along the way through historical signage. The North Carolina Legislature has designated 2023 to be The Year of the Trail and Milton is poised to be included in this emphasis. The Piedmont Triad Regional Council will be instrumental to this project as plans progress. The Trail has not officially opened as more surface preparations and fencing installations are yet to be completed.

New on Milton's streetscape is **The Milton 66 Beer Garden**. Located in what had been a gas station, long closed, "The 66" celebrated its grand opening in August and offers craft beer, local wines and seasonal garden center items. The "roadside market" will additionally host workshops and food trucks as they seek to serve as a community hub of creativity and connection. Check out their website and Facebook page.

"The Jones House" was restored last fall to be offered as an Airbnb site. The Jones House accommodations receive stellar reviews and has been chosen to receive one of Preservation NC's Gertrude S. Carraway 2022 awards of merit for historic

preservation. Although excellently restored a number of years ago, "The Oliver House" is also newly hosted with Airbnb. Go to the Airbnb online site, then search Milton, NC, to find information on both rentals.

Melville/Winstead House is getting a new portico. As the work has progressed over the summer, the sight of towering Greek architectural columns has stopped traffic a time or two in order for motorists to appreciate the original appearance of this c.1835 home being restored.

The former Christ (Episcopal) Church/Milton Woman's Club. which stands on the corner at Milton's only stoplight, has been acquired and donated to Milton Renaissance Foundation to be used as event space and additional museum space. State historic site planners are looking to include the museum's current home, "The Milton State Bank," as part of the Thomas Day State Historic Site, thus the current museum will require a new space. Preparations are being made for **Milton Renaissance**

Performance and Museum Annex to host its first event, a presentation and recognition of historical preservationist Ruth Little's past work in Milton, on September 17.

Just outside Milton's eastern boundary, work is steadily progressing on a new campground facility. David Chopoton, along with wife Trina, plan to open primitive sites at Country **Line Creek Campground** in late August. In Spring of 2023, the couple expects to have bath houses as well as RV hook-ups ready. Also by spring, their "old-timey general store" with crafts, candles, potpourri, t-shirts and various canned goods should be ready for business. Roadside signage at the campground site should be installed soon with contact information.

All in all, hopes are high that Milton will become increasingly more appealing as a destination stop instead of a place through which to merely pass.•





CEAD Update.

PCC's Center for Education and Agriculture Development in Pelham begins phase 1 and already demonstrates economic impact in Caswell County.

Piedmont Community College (PCC) is excited that the first phase of the Center for Education and Agriculture Development (CEAD) is fully funded, and teams are working steadily on the design stage. This first phase of the project includes a Food Hub in partnership with 4P Foods and incubator farm plots. Many local farmers are currently supplying 4P Foods with local, Caswell-grown products that are sent all over the region, and many more farmers are working with officials to begin producing for them as well. CEAD is already having significant economic impacts for the community.

PCC continues to work closely with its partners, including Caswell County Agriculture Extension Office, Caswell County government, and the Piedmont Progressive Farmers' Cooperative, to maintain progress. In September 2022, the community celebrated these important milestones with a ribbon-cutting ceremony. Stakeholders from across the region attended the event, including many of the project's financial donors which include the Danville Regional Foundation and the North Carolina Tobacco Trust Fund Commission.

The second and third phases of the project include the construction of an education building which will house PCC's Agribusiness Technology program and the afterschool agriculture program for local youth, Breakthrough Learning in Agriculture Science Technology (BLAST!). The site will also include a welding and small engine repair lab, local health clinic, storage for local food pantries, food retail opportunities, an ADA-compliant emergency shelter, and walking trails. •

It has spacious, well-kept grounds perfect for walking, having a picnic, or just plain relaxing. The building features a renovated set of restrooms that appear to have nonstop visitors traveling along U.S. 29.

One of the most interesting features is the Visitor Center itself which is full of interesting maps and travel brochures of a magnitude that may have you saying to yourself, "Wow, I didn't know we had all these great tourist attractions in North Carolina!"

Heading up the staff is manager, Jillian Medlin. Medlin says that she enjoys her role at the visitor center and has developed a real passion for meeting new people and helping them navigate their way through Caswell County. "I love working with people. We have an awesome population in the county and I'm looking for ways to reach out to the community and help them learn what we have to offer."

One of the most interesting things for her is seeing how

many visitors come through from other states and even other countries such as England.

Coffee is offered as well as literature from across the state. "We help people understand what we have to offer in addition to giving out a whole lot of travel directions. People usually ask about what they can do while they're here. It's fun helping them plan a day trip," she says.

In addition to maps and brochures there is a barbecue grill and picnic tables that allow people from the area to enjoy a nice picnic and walk the trail. The center tracks the number of visitors that come through and it is not unusual to have 100 people per day.

Each year the first week in May is National Tourism Week across the United States. The Piedmont Trial Visitor Center participates in special activities during that time. "We welcome all guests, travelers and locals, to come check out the Visitor Center and see how we can help you plan your next trip in the great state of North Carolina!" •

Milton Studio Art Gallery Celebrates 15-Year Anniversary.

The Bureau of Labor Statistics reports that only 25% of small businesses make it to 15 years, making Milton Studio Art Gallery's upcoming anniversary particularly worth celebrating. Even more noteworthy, the gallery was not born from a five-year business plan, but due to an unexpected moment of inspiration.

Shirley Cadmus, a retired teacher, had stopped by the Milton Post Office and noticed an empty building across the street, a building at the time owned by Mary Frances Brooks. After talking with Brooks, Cadmus says she went home, and while she had never thought of opening a business in her life, she remembers, "I just kept thinking about (the empty space) being filled with paintings and it stayed in my mind day and night."

In order to ease the cost of rent, Cadmus found likeminded partners in Mimi Games, an artist who specializes in Icon and plein air painting, and whimsical and colorful abstract painter Chrystal Hardt. A thrift store in Roxboro proved a good supply source for display surfaces and hanging grids for paintings, and Hardt's father made a counter from repurposed wood. The Milton Studio Art Gallery opened its doors on December 3, 2007.

Their initial space developed water leaks and since that building needed significant attention, the gallery moved next door and rented from Jean Scott. The gallery hosted a myriad of book signings, including Scott's when her Milton Memories was published, and Sundays were reserved for poetry readings.

Artist Mark Anthony rented space in the gallery while she painted the famous mural of Miltonians eating pizza that is above the counter area at Aunt Millie's. More and




more artists brought in their work, and it wasn't long before Cadmus was only left with a tiny space in the back in which to paint. Eventually, Games and Hardt both needed to move their studio space to Hillsborough, but Cadmus has remained and has added much to Milton's Commercial Row over the years. The gallery represents over 65 artists, providing a place for them to sell as well as providing an attractive place of interest for Milton tourists and locals.

Health problems have prevented Cadmus from firing pottery as she once did, but she has discovered a new art form in 3-D pen work, using plant-based, yet plastic-like, filaments to create sculptured art. Several of her 3-D sculptures were recently accepted in national juried art shows in Greenville, NC and in Goldsboro, NC.

Reflecting on her time as a gallery proprietor, Cadmus shares, "I love to talk to people from different places...so it's been a very good experience meeting people. I love sending checks to the artists, and finding homes for their work. It's been a very good 15 years."

The public was invited to visit Milton Studio Art Gallery located in Milton's Commercial Row on December 3. A good time was had by all and everyone enjoyed the special reception food provided by Milltown Eatery and Saloon. •

Despite taking some time for locals to fully grasp the concept of shared workspaces, the CoSquare Shared Workspace facility in downtown Yancevville, is contributing greatly to the economic development in the county. Right here in this small town is the home to guite an amazing group of professionals that call Caswell County home and also work here for major corporations. Each day the facility is home to at least 12 different companies several of which are on the Fortune 500 list. Others are independent contractors or solo-prenuers (entrepreneurs that run their own business and do not have any employees aside from themselves, for now).

This asset in the heart of Yanceyville, although started as an entrepreneurial incubator, has truly become the place to 'work' in Yanceyville. As the workplace has evolved post pandemic allowing many to work from home, Caswell County has been a desirable location for many families relocating to a more calm and serene rural life. CoSquare provides a place for the professionals that are moving here, 'to have it all.'

If you need access to one gig of internet, then you too may want

to join the working space too. For as little as \$50 per month, full access to the internet, copy machines, scanners and conference rooms are available. Quick conversations with several CoSquare members revealed a glimpse as to the work going on here.

Help Desk for the World --- Downtown Yancevville

Kent is a Caswell County native and resident of Florida, who makes frequent visits to Caswell to assist with the care of his aging parents. He is a contract help desk operations manager for Cox Edge based out of Atlanta. The company provides last mile cloud service to enterprise users.

Not only does he take care of this role, but Kent is a licensed Quick Books consultant and assists small businesses with the online version of Quick Books. He has clients all over the country for this work and to think they all are being taken care of right here in Caswell! With a Masters in IT Security, and a doctorate in the works, having this professional business person in our county is a real plus!





Entrepreneurial Family - Meet Santanna Mimms

Santanna and her husband both office their businesses in CoSquare. Mimms Contractors is run by her husband and Santanna is building a business targeted to toddlers called Tiny Tribe. The soft play fun packages offer toddlers that may be too small for a traditional bounce house a fun way to interact with others. The Tiny Tribe set up was a big hit at the fall Hoedown festival and Santanna says, "I absolutely love being a part of CoSquare. It was the best fit for us. I personally love that everything is included in our suite fee. Your internet, desk, chairs a fully functioning kitchen, conference rooms and so much more."

Living the Dream - Meet Will

It was CoSquare alone that attracted Will and his wife to Caswell County. As a military veteran having lived across the state, they were seeking acreage for their young family within a manageable radius of Will's employer where he could work remotely. His wife, Stefanie, discovered CoSquare online and they immediately made the decision to relocate here where they now have chickens, pigs, and are happy to be able to experience the American Dream here in Caswell while maintaining a professional level role as the Accounting Team Lead for Relias, a company that helps its clients deliver better clinical and financial outcomes by reducing variation in healthcare. Will shared that the facility at CoSquare is as nice as the corporate office that he used to work out of in Morrisville.

Mission: Caswell Arts - Meet Karen Williamson.

Locals may already know Karen as the Executive Director of the Caswell Arts Council. Karen shares, "Having our office here in CoSquare gives us more visibility, more foot traffic, and the opportunity to interact more frequently with local businesses... thus strengthening our varied relationships." The Arts Council enjoys using the audio-visual equipment to show productions that local filmmakers have created. They hosted their annual members meeting at CoSquare with great success and co-hosted an innovative program partnering with the local VFWs, American Legion, Caswell County Senior Center, and Racing for Heroes. Among the other tenants at CoSquare are a couple of local organizations like the Caswell County Chamber of Commerce, Piedmont Community College, and a few local nonprofits including Cool Beans. Yet others making CoSquare home are employees from corporations like a pharmaceutical company Amazon, Hanes Brands, and Vanguard Financial Services. Also present is an international organizational business development consultant, accounting professionals, and a home care agency. Not bad for a small rural town!

Gone are the days of needing a factory full of hourly workers to constitute growth in an economy. Because these large companies have employees in the county with high level salaries, it provides a unique way to experience economic growth contributing greatly to our tax base. In the service economy we live in today the opportunities for Caswell to continue to grow in this way is great. •





Caswell Farmers Market, Caswell Food Pantry CSA Program & The Community Lunches Return

The Caswell County Local Fool Council is the local nonprofit organization that operates the Caswell Farmers Market and is involved in other projects regarding the local food system in Caswell County.

North Carolina is a leading state in building councils across the state. The state works closely with Community Food Strategies and the Local Food Councils of NC to assist with building systems that will work in the various areas. The councils are charged with doing all types of food related work like farmers markets, food pantries/banks, food policy advocacy, food educational training and other food related issues.

Because food is a fundamental need for all and touches our lives in the most basic ways, if a food system is out of balance, meaning people do not have access to healthy food or do not have a connection to where it is grown or distributed, then they may not have a voice in rectifying the problems.

A local food council will work to solve these issues, improve health outcomes, protect natural resources, support economic development, and aid the work of farmers. Ideally, the councils are made up of community members and local organizations coming from all sectors that meet to build relationships, leverage resources, and learn from one another all with the goal of influencing the redesign of their food system. They work to shift the system by encouraging and influencing policies (and practice) that are designed with health and community wellness as an end goal. In Caswell the local food council works together with the cooperative extension office, chamber, local churches, the Caswell Chapter of the Health Collaborative, and other groups.

The Caswell County Local Food Council and the first farmer's markets in Caswell were initially established by Leslie Zimmerman, Tammy Carter, Stokes Regan, and Rebecca Page. These ladies retired from the board in 2021. The CCLFC continued to move forward with several other founding board members and representation from the local Caswell cooperative extension team.


For 2023, new initiatives include a food pantry CSA (community supported agriculture) distribution outreach project. This initiative

partners the food pantries with local farmers in getting their food to community households that are in the most need of healthy fresh produce.

Back by popular demand, in February 2023, the community lunches are returning on the second Wednesday each month. All are invited to attend these complimentary lunches featuring locally sourced food. Come and enjoy fellowship with your community, chances to win small prizes, recipes and education/sharing on the food produced in Caswell. Stay tuned for location announcements.

In North Carolina, there are hundreds of trails for people to get out and explore, including a couple right here in Caswell. Visit NC the official tourism promotional agency for the state, has declared 2023 "The Year of the Trail," keeping with North Carolina's branding of "The Great Trail State."

In a message from The Great Trail State Coalition, "Trail use has increased more than 300% in some places in the last year. The pandemic has demonstrated how eager North Carolinians are for safe places to be outside in nature."

If you haven't seen some of the local Caswell trails, now is a wonderful time to get acquainted with them. The Senior Center Tails system includes several footpaths in Yanceyville. The Stream Walk is a gravel fitness trail that creates a loop around the senior center. The Flatland Trail is relatively flat in nature trail that provides opportunities for wildlife viewing and reflection. The Hillside Trail links to the Orchard-Lake Trail which provides a connection to Yoder's Market.

Also in Yanceyville at the Maud Gatewood Park, there is a paved walking trail that is ideal for getting outside a bit and enjoying a short walk. The area also has picnic tables and a covered shelter area.

In Milton, there are expanding opportunities to get out and feel the fresh air and enjoy some time in nature too. The Milton Heritage Greenway Trails program has just cleared Milton's Old Crop Street behind Commercial Row. The trail is partnering with the Gunn Memorial Library in a storybook initiative that will be incorporated into the walk for the children.

Through the Piedmont Triad Regional Council, local TDA, the Chamber of Commerce and Piedmont Triad Visitor Center, individuals are connecting with resources to help expand opportunities in Caswell. The groups work to make sure we can provide residents, as well as folks visiting our area, with the best possible nature experience while using the trials here.

There will be a 2023 Year of the Trail Caswell Event at some time in the year, but details have not been finalized at this writing. •

or grown. There were offerings like plants and terrariums, hand-made crocheted items, nail painting services, art items, and baked goods. And to top the actual youth market, each young person was asked to go up on stage and provide a quick one-to-two-minute commercial about their offerings so the audience would know that they had to sell. The adults at the event were very impressed at the courage these young people had getting up on the stage and speaking so well to the crowd.

Later in the year, at the Bright Leaf Hoedown, a similar event was planned by Cool Beans wherein the youth could get exposure with their entrepreneurial ideas. There were multiple youth marketers selling their goods. Again, an on-stage appearance to market their goods was involved. Most of these youth participated in a day camp with Cool Beans where they learned key steps required to get a business going, how to market the items, and how to interact with customers in a professional way.

There are other organizations in the community that are working to assist the youth too. The Caswell 4-H have camps each summer and several Scout Troops work to teach leadership skills to their participants. In addition, there are other organizations that assist with after school programs via tutoring and children's programs like area churches, the Community Outreach Ministry, and Pinnacol Tutoring Groups. Many of these groups welcome volunteers to assist in developing the youth of Caswell.

Caswell County has so many smart young students that need and appreciate encouragement from adults. Adults can take an active role in stopping the 'brain drain' (ves that is an official term) in the rural community by helping the young people in our lives see the possible options here vs. encouraging them all to leave and be successful elsewhere. With online colleges and the program Piedmont Community College has to graduate Bartlett Yancev Senior High School students with an associate degree, cost effective options exist. The opportunities to work for companies from all over the country remotely create a new path for a future that can be built here in Caswell allowing youth to stay here, grow families, and help strengthen the community. This can create a totally new landscape for the community. Already there is a wave of young families headed back to Caswell after being away for a time realizing there is no better place to raise a family than a place like Caswell.
