7:00 PM**

The Recess Meeting of the Town Council was held in the Council Chambers at the Yanceyville Municipal Services Building on March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 7:00 PM.

**Call to Order**

Mayor Alvin Foster called the Recess Meeting back to order at 7:00pm. Mayor Foster stated that we have one item to discuss tonight.

**Pavilion Use Policy Discussion “Steers and Cheers” Festival.**

Town Manager Collie stated that this was a March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018 agenda item. He stated that the Piedmont Progressive Farmers Group (PPFG), Caswell Local Foods Council (CCLFC) and Piedmont Community College (PCC), are the three local non-profit organizations would like to host an event. They’re requesting that the event be held at the Town’s Pavilion and they would like to sell and serve alcoholic beverages from local craft breweries at the Event. On June 16<sup>th</sup> from 2-6 pm they are looking to celebrate rural North Carolina by roasting a whole steer, locally raised while enjoying regional beverages delicious sides with a local flair, live entertainment including music and agricultural demonstrations. Local farmers will also have interactive booths showcasing best practices for up and coming agriculturalists and farming enthusiasts. Town Manager Collie noted that the meeting was recessed due to the current Pavilion Use Policy not allowing consumption of alcohol on Town Property. Town Manager explained that the current Pavilion Use Policy would have to be amended, if Town Council desires.

Town Manager Collie noted the Addendum A on page eight specifically referred to 5a. on page five of the Pavilion Use Policy.

5. Alcoholic beverages and drugs are not permitted. Furthermore, no persons under the influence of alcohol drugs shall be permitted to utilize the Pavilion.

5a. Alcoholic beverages may be served at special events if a permit is approved through the requirements listed in Addendum A at the end of the policy.

After discussion among Council, Mayor Foster made a motion to pass the Pavilion Use Policy with the changes on page eight Addendum A adding “The Renter should be a nonprofit organization” and inserting wine after beer. The motion was seconded by Councilman Tatum and pass with a three to two vote.

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**Item 12: Adjournment**

Mayor Foster asked Council for a motion to adjourn. After no further discussion, Mayor Pro Tem Gwynn made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilman Massey and passed with a unanimous vote.
